On successful completion of your Assessment week you will be awarded the Monty Roberts Introductory Certificate and the Intelligent Horsemanship Diploma Certificate. If you would like to be considered to become a Recommended Trainer (Associate), depending on your grades from the Stage 2 you will be given between 1 and 3 years to work on your portfolio of Case Studies

Important Time limit Note

Your Stage 2 Assessment Week should be taken within 3 years of taking the 5 Day Foundation Course, otherwise you will be asked to take the Foundation course again as a refresher.

For example, applying for Assessment Week, if you take the Foundation Course in 2015 you would need to attend the Stage 2 by 2018/19 and so on. Students' who took the Foundation Course before 2009 will need to retake the Foundation Course.
